




#### **Social Work Scoop**

This year we will be using the WhyTry program to teach social and emotional principles to our students in a way they can understand and remember. WhyTry is based on sound principles, including social and emotional intelligence, and multisensory learning. The WhyTry curriculum utilizes a series of ten visual analogies that teach important life skills (e.g., decisions have consequences; dealing with with peer pressure; obeying laws and rules; plugging in to support systems). The visual analogies are reinforced through the creative use of customized hip-hop music, video, over 150 learning
