

SENIOR INFORMATION - updated Monday June 29

GRADUATION

1. For your 8 tickets needed for admittance to the Graduation Ceremony on Friday July 10, we will begin distribution next Monday July 6. You can pick them up in the office Monday - Wednesday from 9 - 2. Those not picked up will be handed out at Graduation practice Thursday morning. Only those individuals with tickets will be allowed in the gymnasium. The ceremony will be live streamed for others to watch. The link to the live stream will be posted on the South Spencer High School Facebook page and on the SSHS website.
2. Yard Signs - Please bring your signs with you to practice Thursday morning. We would like to have them displayed Friday evening at Graduation
3. Graduation Practice Thursday July 9 - **This is mandatory. If you are working and cannot be at practice you must let us know before Thursday.**
You will need to arrive @ 8:00 in the main gym. Everyone will need to bring your cap, gown and tassel for the 2020 Class picture. Individual pics will be taken at any time from 8:00 - 8:45. The class pic will be at 9:00. Girls do not have to dress up unless you are having an individual pic taken by the professional photographer. Boys need to wear a dress shirt and tie for the class pic. If you are sitting in the front row (BETA Club members)..... girls wear nice shoes and boys will need to wear nice pants and shoes.
4. Graduation begins at 7:00 Friday evening July 10.
 - You need to arrive at the aux. Gym between 5:15 and 5:30.
 - Dress is very important. Girls must wear a dress or dress pants with appropriate shoes. Nice sandals are good. Boys wear a dress shirt and tie. Dress pants and shoes. **Jeans and tennis shoes are not allowed.**
5. Doors will open to the public at 5:30.
 - We ask that family groups follow social distancing guidelines, from other family groups, before, during, and after the ceremony.
 - Face masks are recommended, but not required, since we can social distance.
 - We ask that students socially distance before, during, and after the ceremony.
 - There will be a window of opportunity for group pictures between friend groups, but ask that students socially distance during this opportunity.
 - Seniors will be seated on the gym floor, with half on the north side and half on the south side. Please know which side you are on so parents will know where best to sit.

6. Prom - Timeline for the prom is as follows:
 - 7:40 Grand March in the Auditorium. The public is not allowed. It will be live streamed for viewing.
 - 8:00 Dinner will be served in the commons
 - 9:00 - 11:15 Prom at AEP
 - 12:00 After Prom at the HS
 - **For all who are attending (seniors and guests) permission slips must be signed and returned to the HS no later than Thursday July 9. Prom is a voluntary activity and you need to verify that you are attending at your own risk.**
